It is estimated to arrive at the port of Beira in Mozambique on 24th July and from there it goes overland to Lilongwe, where it has to wait for customs clearance before going to Salima.

The third classroom and a teachers' office at Trinity school Moyo are starting to be constructed this month.

The foundations are already being laid and a team from Mission Direct will soon be traveling to Malawi to build the walls.

This will mean the school will have classrooms for standards 1 to 6.

Secondary School Sponsorship

We are coming to the time of year when we will be receiving requests from students who have passed their exams and are ready to go to secondary school, to be sponsored through the next four years as their families are unable to afford the fees.

The monthly cost is £20 or £240 for a full year for each student, with the education period being 4 years. Sponsorship provides for school fees, board, food, most books and a small amount of pocket money. Assistance is provided for those who cannot afford uniforms. Sponsors receive details of their students background and a yearly school progress report and students write one letter to their sponsors every term.

Each year we have more requests than we can support, so it would be very much appreciated if we could encourage more new sponsors to get involved in this important programme, which allows students the chance of having a good education and prospects of going to university or college.
