**RE: Roman Workshop** 

Next term, Year 3 will be learning about **Romans.** To further enhance the children's topic learning, we have booked a fun, absorbing and interactive workshop all about Romans.

The Workshop is run by Portals of the Past. The workshop will take place at school on **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2025.** 

The children will explore the dramatic change in the lifestyle of even the lowliest citizens following the arrival of the Roman legions, take a tour through a bath-house and experience the excitement of the games arena. Real Roman artefacts provide the opportunity to get a real hands-on experience of history. Other activities include:

- Delta a Roman numeral, maths-based game
- Roman quiz
- Segedunum a simple and fun Roman game
- A display of Roman and Celtic weapons and armour
- Boudicca's final battle with the Romans

The day finishes with a gladiator show, in which the children have all the important roles, from slaves through to the mighty Emperor.

To further add to the experience, I would also like to invite the children to come to school dressed as a Roman or a Celt. You will find attached some suggestions as to what your child could wear to school on the day.
