**Reception Class:****Song: Aladdin**

The children will be performing a song about Aladdin. Please provide your child with black leggings/shorts/trousers or a skirt, and a brightly coloured plain t-shirt.

**Year 1:****Song: In the Market Place**

The children will be marketplace traders. They could wear clothes as if they are selling goods at an Arabian market. This could be skirts, trousers, shorts, a plain black/brown/white T-shirt/dress/tabard/ waistcoat with perhaps a shawl/ scarf and/or a tea towel/fez for a headdress.

**Year 2:****Song: I've Had Enough**

A song about Princess Jasmine. The children could wear brightly coloured or Arabian style clothes – such as hareem trousers/waistcoat/ skirt/tops etc, but please do not go to lots of expense to buy costumes especially for this!

**Year 3:****Song: Just Three Wishes**

This song is linked to the appearance of the genie. Children are welcome to wear brightly coloured Arabian style costumes, or any type of sparkly/brightly coloured clothes that add a touch of bling. Sunglasses/accessories etc also welcome! Please do not go to lots of expense to buy costumes especially for this!

**Year 4:****Song: New Lamps for Old**

A song linked to the evil plans of Abanazar. Children could wear black clothes with a perhaps a splash of red somewhere! Feel free to apply some black eyeliner/face paints to create a sinister look on the night!

**Year 5:****Song: Wishy Washy Laundry**

A larger-than-life, colourful number in Widow Twankey's Laundry. Children could wear bold, mixed patterns, garish outfits as if they are wearing the contents of the laundry themselves, for example, stripy socks, bright t-shirts, trousers, shirts, shorts, tutus, oversized pants on top of tights/trousers, crazy accessories etc. Go wild!
