


<p>English:</p> <p>This half term, our focus text will be the '<i>City of Rust</i>' by Gemma Fowler. This will be our main class text in guided reading sessions, as well as a stimulus for some creative writing.</p> <p>Linking with our topic on the environment in geography and evolution in science, we will create our own imaginative and descriptive texts, non-chronological reports and write nature documentary style narratives.</p> <p>Grammar, punctuation and spelling learning will be ongoing throughout the term as well as developing specific reading domain skills.</p>	<p>Mathematics:</p> <p>We will be focusing on the following areas in mathematics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order of operations • Fractions (converting and ordering fractions, comparing and calculating with fractions). • Converting units of measure. <p>We will also continue to revise topics previously taught and continue to develop our confidence with arithmetic.</p> <p>RE:</p> <p>Our RE learning will focus around the key questions- What do Christians believe about the Messiah and why is it good news?</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>In Geography we will be answering these key questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where is longitude, latitude and the Earth's equator? Where are the different time zones in the World? Why? • What and where are the world climate zones and biomes? • What is climate change/ global warming? What has contributed to climate change? • How is climate change affecting the world's biomes and oceans? • What is human/physical geography? • How and why have cities grown? How does growth of cities affect physical features? • How have extreme weather events affected different countries?
<p>Design and Technology</p> <p>We will be using old clothes and fabric to design and make an upcycled textile product, such as a bag or waistcoat. We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago -recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents -identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution -We will also explore the life and study of Charles Darwin within this unit and read the text, 'Moth- An Evolution Story' by Isabel Thomas. 		<p>PE: We will be doing the unit 'Movement' in gymnastics in indoor PE.
